## Psalm 24

David's aim is that Yahweh would be worshipped in truth as creator, savior, and king by true worshippers of him.

**Contemplation**: Worship Jesus the Creator (vs 1-2)

Consecration: Worship Jesus the Savior (vs 3-6)

<u>Commemoration</u>: Worship Jesus the Coming King (vs 7-10)
